Antique and fine art collectors will be busy getting their checkbooks out during the week of January 18, with two major contemporary and antique art shows taking place on opposite sides of the globe. Historic artifacts will be on display at FADA in the US while in Europe, the 55th edition of the Brussels Antiques & Fine arts Fair is set to draw a large crowd of visitors.

The Fine Art Dealers Association's Los Angeles Art Show is in its 15th year. In 2009 35,000 visitors attended the show and organizers expect this year's event to be even bigger. More than 130 international galleries will feature an array of contemporary, modern and historical art. Visitors can also enhance their visit to the show by attending a special program of lectures, mixer events and other specially organized events including the IFPDA Print Fair. There will be a sculpture garden, special exhibit spaces
