■ Commencing with its celebrity-studded opening gala January 23, the L.A. Art Show is one of the country's most prestigious art expositions. Significant works — spanning history's finest artists, including Ansel Adams and Picasso, to cutting-edge contemporary from some of today's emerging talent — will be available for purchase.

The show is the collaborative effort of more than 125 distinguished U.S. and international galleries and for the first time this year, welcomes the addition of the IFPDA's Fine Print Fair. In 2007, the L.A. Art Show set records both in terms of sales, at more than \$15 million, and attendance by 20,000 people.

In addition to the opening gala and daily shows, the event features a much-lauded lecture series with celebrated art experts, including Jori Finkel, who will be back for her *Art Lover's Boot Camp* and Peter Fetterman, who will present *Collecting Fine Art Photography*.
