FADA's Los Angeles Art Show is a Masterpiece

The 12th Annual Los Angeles Art Show, presented by the Fine Art Dealers Association (FADA), returns to the area on Wednesday, January 24 through Sunday, January 28 at the Barker Hangar at the Santa Monica Airport.

Titled "Five Centuries of Fine Art", visitors to the show will have an opportunity to view art from around the world that are available for purchase. Eighty international galleries will display old masters, 19th Century, modern and contemporary works of art. In response to the popularity of the show, this year an additional 32,000-square-foot of pavilion space will be built adjacent to the Hangar to supplement the added gallery participation and guest attendance. Proceeds from the Los Angeles Art Show Opening Night Gala, which will be held Wednesday, January 24 from 7:00 to 10:00pm, will be donated to the Art Museum Council of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA) to underwrite its exhibit, "The Arts in Latin America, 1492-1820", which is opening later this year.

The Los Angeles Art Show caters to the novice and advanced collector alike, offering a unique chance to view and purchase works of the highest quality, spanning many styles and a broad price range. Several local museums are partici-

pating in the show, including LACMA, the Autry National Center, Irvine Museum, Los Angeles Art Association, Gallery 825, Museum of Latin American Art, and the Ventura County Museum of History and Art. Approximately 20,000 visitors are expected to attend.

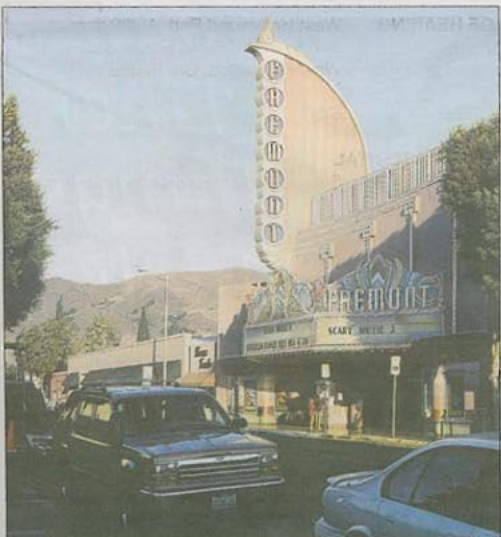
