Los Angeles Art Show

Celebrating its 11th year, the Los Angeles Art Show returns to Barker Hangar in Santa Monica with its new winter dates, January 25-29, 2006.

The show presents a rare opportunity for seasoned collectors as well as first-time art fair visitors to view and purchase works representing "Five Centuries of Fine Art." More than 50 top domestic and international galleries will display a range of work from Old Masters and Impressionists to traditional art with a regional flavor (such as Western Art, Taos School, and California Impressionism) as well as Abstract Expressionism, Pop, Minimalism, and other contemporary art. All work is vetted for provenance and authenticity.

In addition to the fine works of art on view and sale, an engaging array of art and design events and lectures will take place at the Los Angeles Art Show throughout the weeklong event. A collection of design

vignettes will demonstrate how works of fine art can be skillfully integrated into a contemporary interior. A series of lectures and symposia, featuring the most distinctive voices in the art world today, will take place during the show.

Exceptional works by Los Angeles-based artists will be highlighted in a number of art installations throughout Barker Hangar. These installations are intended to place the innovative work of today's emerging artists within the broader context of "Five Centuries of Art" on display at the show.

A festive Opening Night Gala preview, benefiting the Art Museum Council of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art, will be held Wednesday evening, January 25, 2006 (for advance tickets, call 323-857-6149).
