For 2022, DIVERSEartLA, curated by Marisa Caichiolo, will present artistic visions that address the global climate crisis while advancing potential solutions. This week we highlight, *The Other Waterfall & Chapala Also Drops Itself* by Claudia Rodriguez. The exhibit is presented by MUSA Museum of the Arts of the University of Guadalajara and MCA Museum of Environmental Science, through the University of Guadalajara Foundation | USA, the Universidad de Guadalajara.



Two installations by the artist Claudia Rodríguez: La otra cascada –The Other Waterfall – and Chapala también se-a-gota – Chapala also Drops Itself – reflect the impact of scarce and contaminated water on the state of Jalisco, Mexico in recent decades.



The MUSA Museum of the Arts exhibition program seeks to motivate social

transformation. Through its focus on protecting the natural environment, MUSA was one of the first university properties that implemented sustainable actions related to the management and recycling of waste as well as the rational use of water and energy.


Gallery Highlight: Melissa Morgan Fine Art Gallery
