Arcadia Contemporary

Established in 2001 as Arcadia Fine Arts, Arcadia Contemporary has been at the forefront of promoting highly skilled, representational artists. The gallery, initially located in Manhattan's vibrant Soho District, quickly gained international recognition for showcasing works that demonstrated the artists' mastery of painting and drawing techniques, combined with their unique, signature styles.

In 2014, the gallery evolved into Arcadia Contemporary, reflecting its commitment to featuring artists who, while employing timeless techniques, create imagery that resonates with the contemporary world. This shift in focus has allowed Arcadia Contemporary to curate a diverse collection of sculptures, paintings, and photographs by a range of talented contemporary artists.

Among the gallery's roster of artists are Kesja Tabaczuk, Hideo Tanaka, Ivan Franco Fraga, Tim Rees, amongst many others.

From its inception, the gallery's primary focus has been to bridge a blue-chip contemporary program with important, mid-career artists, with a particular emphasis on Southern California. Among the gallery's notable artists are Anthony James, known for his mesmerizing light sculptures; Andy Moses, whose abstract paintings explore the interplay of color and texture; Ed Moses, a seminal figure in the Los Angeles art scene; David Yarrow, a renowned fine art photographer; and Michael Childers, celebrated for his iconic portraits of Hollywood legends.




