
As we work our way up to the LA Art Show's 30th anniversary, we look forward to continuing our collaborations with these galleries and welcoming new exhibitors from around the world.

In 1994, owner Greg Escalante co-founded Juxtapoz magazine, allowing the gallery to collaborate with the publication to curate, publicize, and sponsor events both within the gallery and beyond, further promoting the artists they represent.

Since establishing a permanent location, Copro Gallery has continued to focus on museum-quality installations featuring emerging artists while also exhibiting works by established and master painters.




