LA Art Show 2026: Debut of Latin American Pavilion & Expanded U.K. Galleries

The LA Art Show returns to the Los Angeles Convention Center for its 31st edition from January 7-11, 2026. As LA's largest and longest-established art fair, this year's show will feature over 100 exhibitors, including continued collaborations with international galleries.

New for 2026 is the debut of an invitation-only Latin American Pavilion and the fair's first exhibitors from Ireland, Switzerland, and Poland with Dublin-based Oliver Sears Gallery, Laurent Marthaler Contemporary from Switzerland, and Epicentrum Art Gallery from Poland. The show maintains strong international representation with an expanded presence from United Kingdom galleries and 15 participating South Korean galleries. A highlight of the 2026 edition will be a rare exhibition of abstract paintings by Sylvester Stallone.

Latin American Pavilion

DIVERSEartLA curator Marisa Caichiolo will oversee the LA Art Show's first Latin American Pavilion in 2026. The invitation-only platform will feature emerging artists from across the American Continent, addressing a gap in representation at major international art fairs. Caichiolo, who was recently selected to co-curate Chile's official pavilion at the 61st Venice Biennale of Art in 2026, has curated the pavilion around themes of memory, migration, and identity.

Participating galleries include Artier Fine Art Gallery from Palm Springs, California and Verse Gallery from Fort Lauderdale, Florida. "At a moment when immigration issues continue to disproportionately impact Latin American communities, it is especially important to provide a platform for these artists," Caichiolo notes. "Their perspectives are vital to a more complete and equitable understanding of contemporary art, yet they remain underrepresented at major fairs.

Expanded United Kingdom Presence

The 2026 show marks significant growth in representation from United Kingdom galleries. The fair welcomes several U.K. galleries for the first time, including John Martin Gallery from London and Quantum Contemporary Art. Pontone Gallery, based in London's West End, will present works by self-taught Manchester artist Chris Rivers. A former professional rock drummer, Rivers creates oil paintings and hand-gilded editions inspired by astronomy, mythology, and celestial cartography. His vibrant and surreal works have attracted attention from collectors and high-profile figures. Rebecca Hossack Art Gallery from London returns as an established participant in the fair's international roster.




