LA Art Show Announces Top 3 Booth Awards Juried by DIVERSEartLA

The LA Art Show will present the inaugural **Top 3 Booth Awards** for the 2026 edition, recognizing excellence in booth design, curatorial focus, and visitor engagement. The awards will be juried by DIVERSEartLA, the show's non-commercial platform curated by Marisa Caichiolo.

About the Awards

The Top 3 Booth Awards honor galleries that transform exhibition space into a cohesive narrative, balancing curatorial vision with innovative presentation and inclusive access. The awards recognize booths that create memorable visitor experiences through thoughtful design elements including layout, branding, lighting, typography, wall text, display methods, and audience interaction.

The Jury

This year's jury brings diverse perspectives on curation, narrative, and accessibility to the evaluation process. Jurors include:

Alma Ruiz, Independent Curator. Ruiz is best known for her longtime tenure as curator at The Museum of Contemporary Art Los Angeles (MOCA), where she developed significant exhibitions and programs.

Jonell Logan, Executive Director and Curator of Tephra Institute of Contemporary Art. Logan brings extensive experience in contemporary art programming and institutional leadership to the jury panel.

The awards will be announced during the LA Art Show, taking place this coming week from January 7-11, 2026 at the Los Angeles Convention Center.

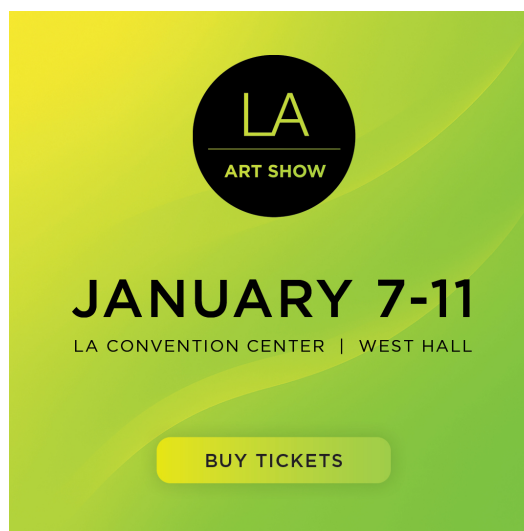

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


