LA Art Show's Opening Night Delivers Record Attendance!

Yesterday's Opening Night Premiere drew the largest crowd in LA Art Show history, setting an energetic tone for the week ahead. Hosted by actress and entrepreneur **Sasha Pieterse**, the evening benefited the **American Heart Association**, our 2026 charity partner, with fifteen percent of all ticket proceeds supporting their Life is Why™ campaign.

Pieterse toured the show with producer and director Cassandra Voyagis, connecting with galleries and visitors throughout the evening. Speaking about her involvement with the American Heart Association, Pieterse has shared, "Heart disease has had a profound impact on my family. I've lost loved ones to heart disease and heart attacks, which makes this cause incredibly close to my heart. Living with PCOS has also heightened my awareness of cardiovascular risk, reinforcing how vital education, research, and early intervention truly are. To be able to gather in celebration of art, creativity, and global voices while also raising critical funds for such an important organization is both meaningful and

deeply inspiring."

Join Us Today: Day 1

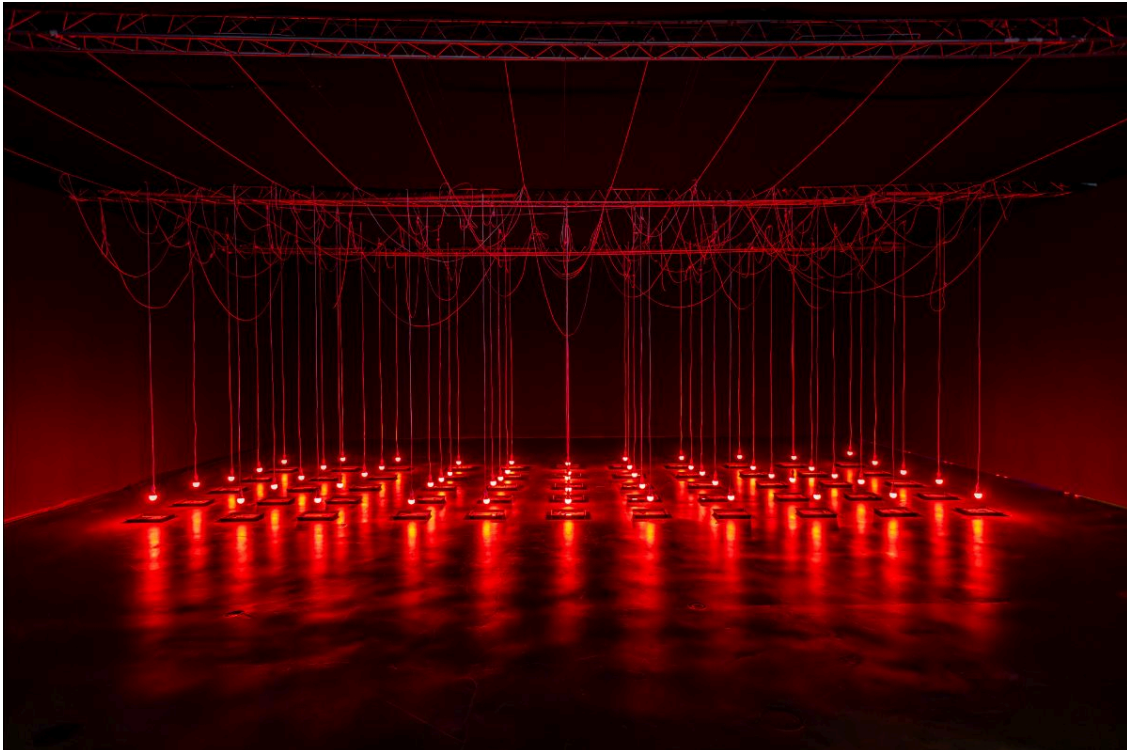
LA Art Show continues today, Thursday, January 8, featuring galleries from around the world presenting work by emerging artists to old masters. This year's edition includes first-time exhibitors from Ireland, Switzerland, Poland, France, Israel, Greece, and South Africa, alongside an expanded presence from United Kingdom galleries and 15 participating South Korean galleries.

DIVERSEartLA 2026: Featured Projects

Our signature curatorial program, DIVERSEartLA, curated by Marisa Caichiolo, examines how contemporary art circulates across a global ecosystem of biennials and art institutions. This year's edition presents seven international biennials and leading institutions. Today we're highlighting two projects not to miss:

AGUAS
Casablanca Biennial 2026

Artist Eugenia Vargas Pereira presents an ongoing exploration of rivers through community participation and ritual cleansing. For DIVERSEartLA, the project centers on the Los Angeles River. Volunteers take selfies placed in developing trays, creating fleeting images that emerge and fade, mirroring our fragile connection to the natural world. Each participant becomes a visual narrator, witnessing environmental flow and the interdependence of humans and nature.



The Roads in You
Gwangju Biennial

Artist Yoon Chung Han presents an interactive biometric artwork that invites participants to scan their veins and discover roads that trace their unique vein patterns. The work examines how vascular networks and road systems share principles of connectivity, flow, and direction. Participants may export their data as personalized 3D-printed sculptures, turning data collection into a tactile, enduring memory.

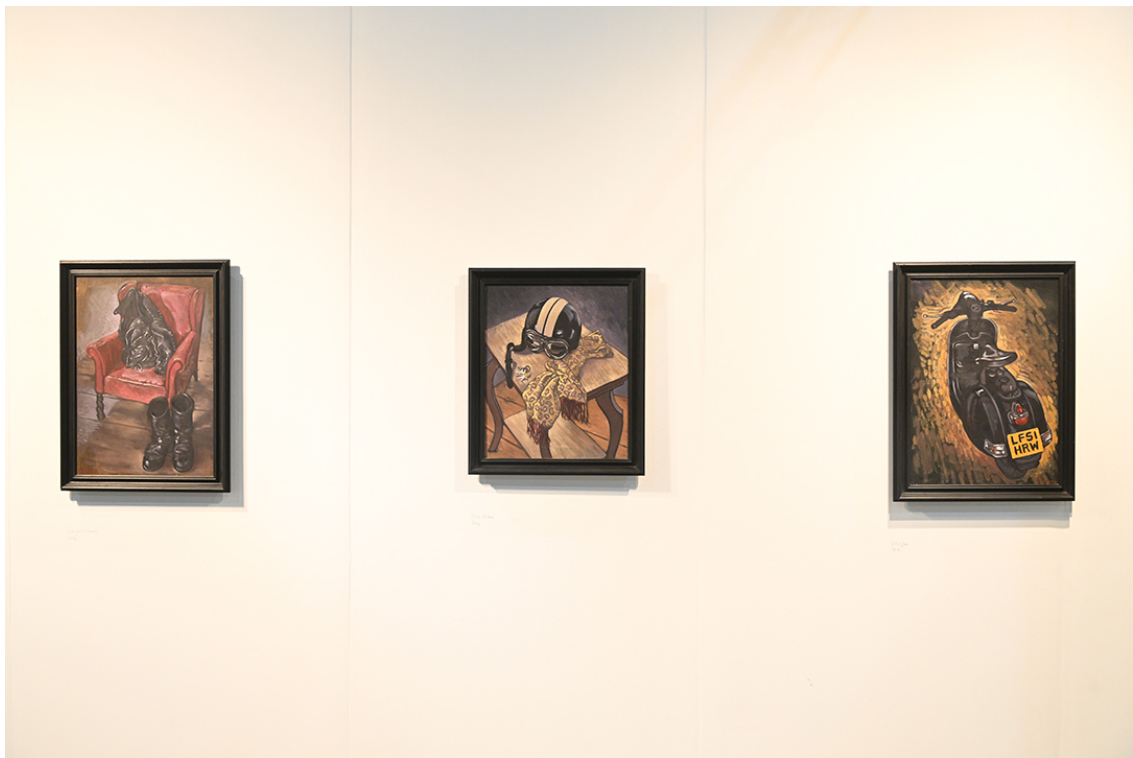

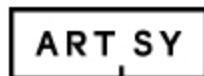


