Join Us for Day 3: An Art-Filled Weekend at LA Art Show

Friday brought strong energy to Day 2 of LA Art Show 2026, with visitors exploring exhibitions and connecting with galleries throughout the day. With two days remaining, there's still time to experience the show this weekend.

We presented the inaugural Top 3 Booth Awards, recognizing excellence in booth design, curatorial focus, and visitor engagement. The awards were juried by **Alma Ruiz**, Independent Curator and former curator at The Museum of Contemporary Art Los Angeles (MOCA), and **Jonell Logan**, Executive Director and Curator of Tephra Institute of Contemporary Art.

When visiting the show, be sure to see the award-winning booths: **Rebecca Hossack Art Gallery**, 1st Place (Booth 503); **Arcadia Contemporary**, 2nd Place (Booth 602); **J&J Art**, 3rd Place (Booth 100); and **Lotus Gallery**, Honorable Mention (Booth 806).

LACC Career Academy Day

Friday marked **LACC Career Academy Day** at LA Art Show. This program partners with Los Angeles Community College to introduce youth from traditionally underserved communities to careers in the arts. LA Art Show Producer/Director **Kassandra Voyagis** spoke with students about career opportunities in arts administration, curation, gallery management, and related fields.

Strong Sales

Galleries have reported strong sales throughout the first few days of the show. Swiss gallery **Laurent Mathaler Contemporary** sold several pieces, including large works by Swiss artist **Simon Berger**, to a prominent Southern California collection. Other international galleries also reported strong activity, with **Rebecca Hossack Art Gallery** and **John Martin Gallery**, both from London, selling multiple works. **Art of Contemporary Africa** from South Africa and **Corridor Contemporary** from Israel reported sales from their respective booths.

Domestically, New York's **Rehs Contemporary** reported solid sales activity. Los Angeles-area galleries showed particularly strong performance, with **Fabrik Projects** selling works by Korean artist **Chuni Park** on opening night, **EK Gallery** reporting multiple sales, and

Bruce Lurie Gallery, known for representing established contemporary artists, also reporting strong sales. Miami's **Coral Gallery** and Santa Monica's **Copro Gallery** also reported strong sales.

Marcos Ramírez ERRE: Biennials of the Past, Themes of the Present Booth 110

Artist Arden Bendler Browning presents a multi-faceted digital installation using projectors, colored light, Mixed Reality headsets, sound, and physical paintings. Visitors explore interactive abstract digital landscapes inspired by plein air drawings and studio impressions. Through Mixed Reality headsets, viewers experience gestural painted virtual environments while walking only steps within the exhibition space.

DIVERSEartLA also highlights several international biennials, including New York Latin American Art Triennial (NYLAAT), Cuenca Biennial (Ecuador) celebrating its 40th anniversary, Nomade Biennial, SACO Biennial (Chile), World Textile Art Biennial, Gwangju Biennial (Korea), and the 61st Venice Biennale 2026 Official Pavilion of Chile, co-curated by Marisa Caichiolo and Dermis León.

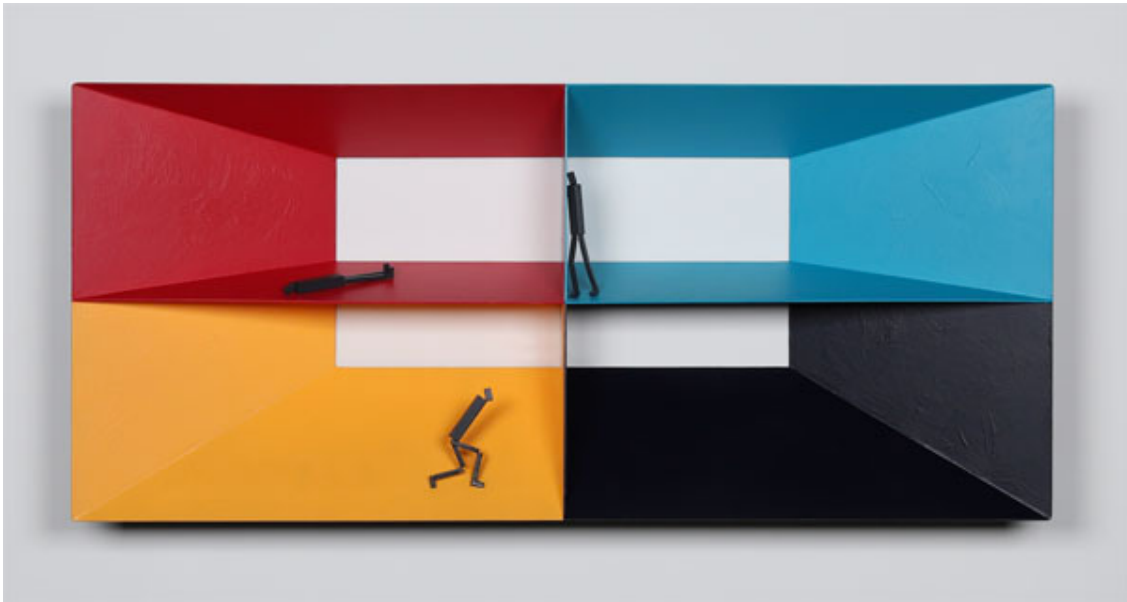
Elegant Freedom: Nature, Tradition, and the Human Spirit J&J Art, Republic of Korea Booth 100

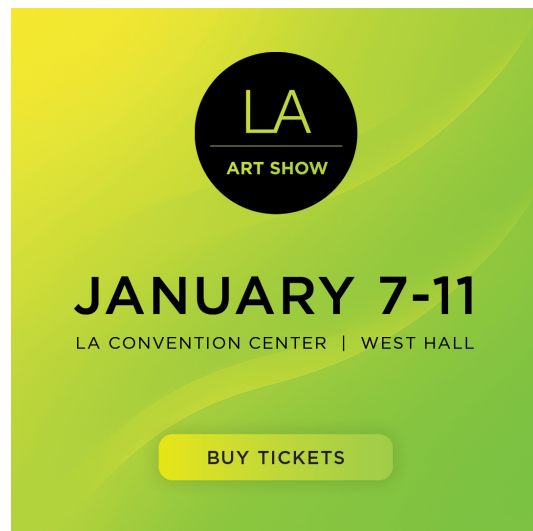

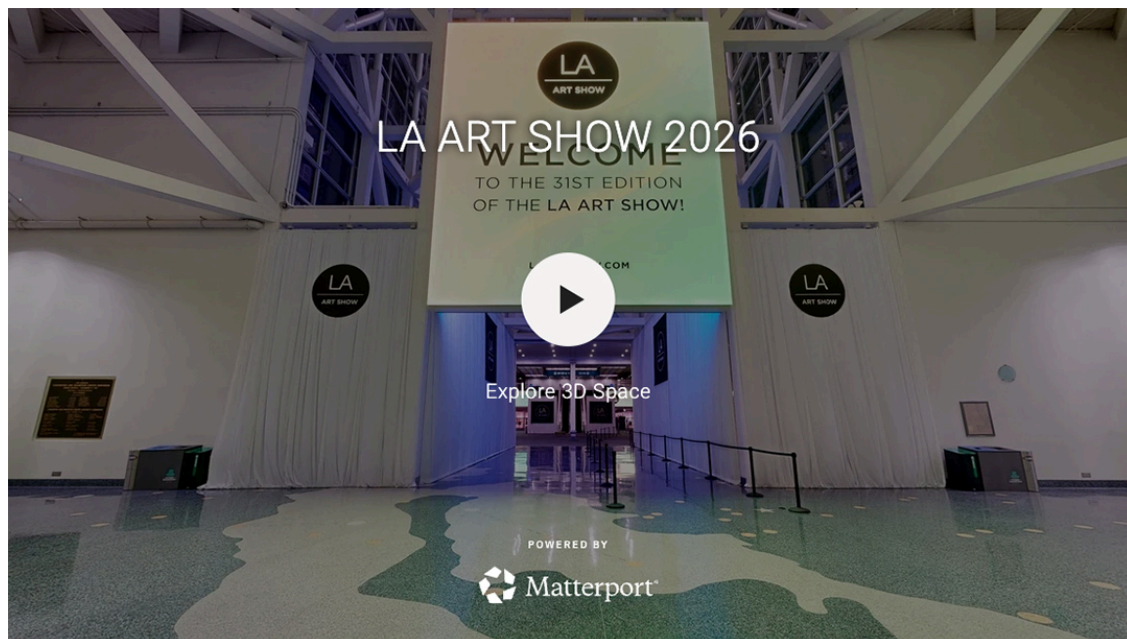


