Thursday was a great first full day at LA Art Show 2024! A steady stream of art lovers poured into the LA Convention Center to enjoy the wonderful programs of our 100+ exhibiting galleries and art organizations, as well as the 2024 edition of our forward-thinking exhibition platform, DIVERSEartLA, curated by Marisa Caichiolo.

We were pleased to present the second edition of the DIVERSEartLA Museum Acquisition Award for Emerging Artists. Selected by Ana Maria Matthei, Director of AAL Museum and founder of AAL Magazine, Chile, the award was presented by DIVERSEartLA curator Marisa Caichiolo to Pigment Gallery for the artwork Nervion, by artist Juan Escudero. The artwork will become part of the permanent collection of AAL Museum, Chile. We're thrilled that this initiative made the acquisition possible!

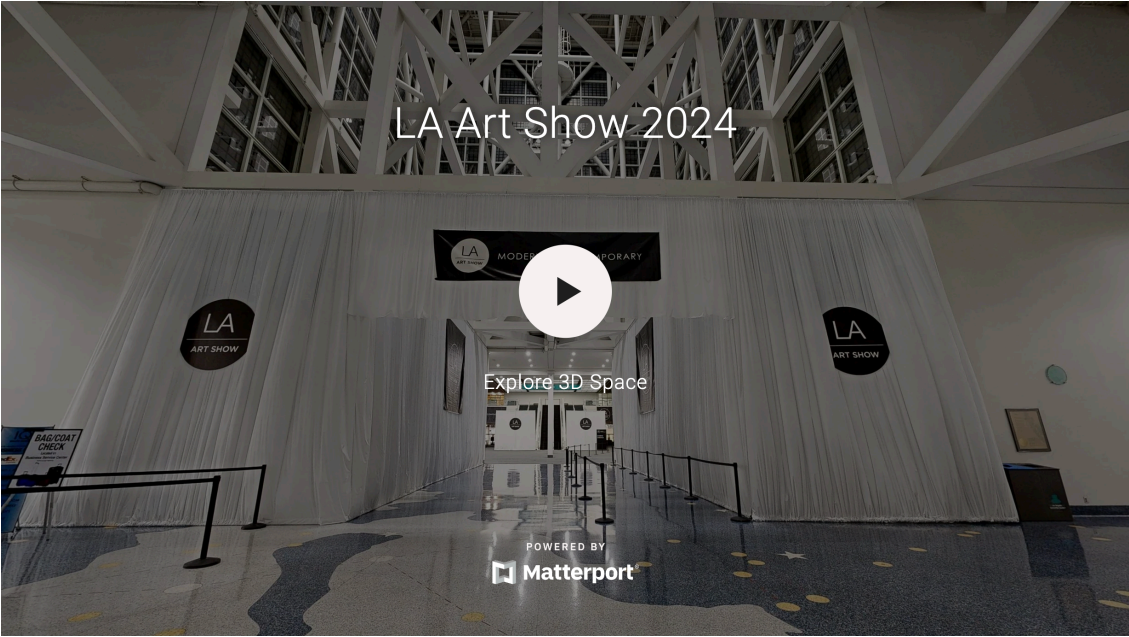
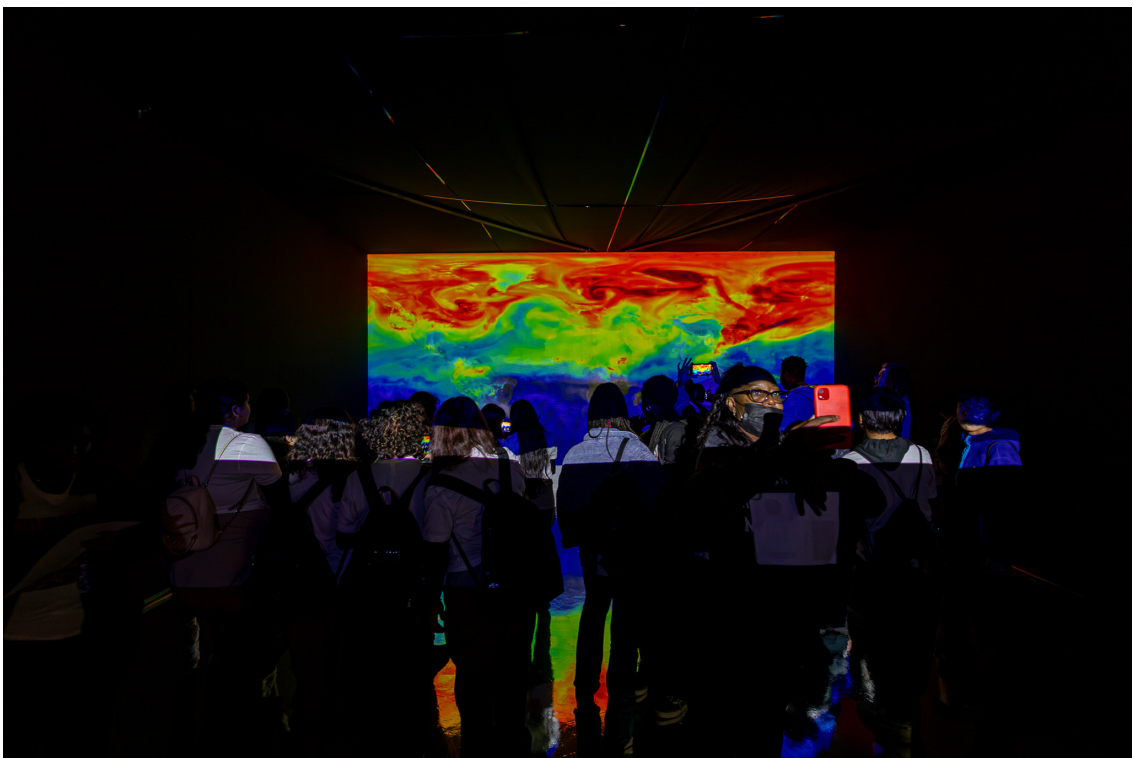
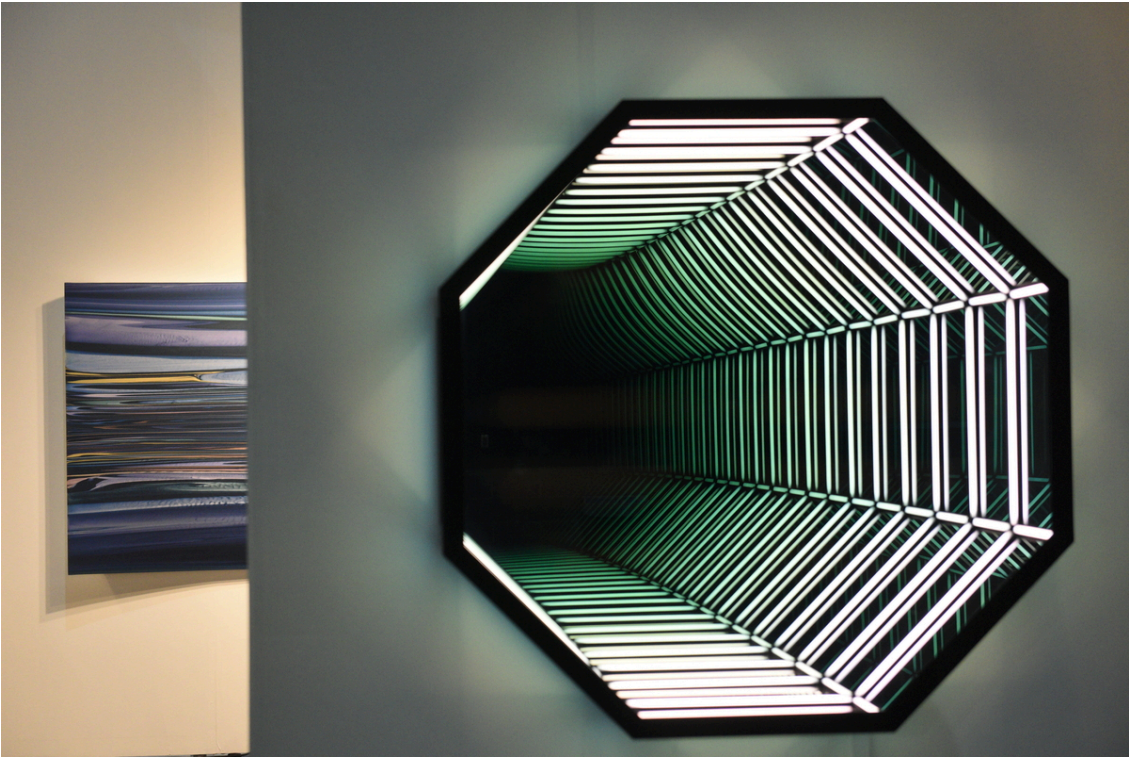
