Art in Dongsan presents a special live performance by acclaimed artist Choi Sori. “Visible Sound: Wish Into the Wind,” is a multimedia piece that invites us to reflect on the origins of life and the majesty of nature. Through drumming and manipulation of metal surfaces. Choi Sori creates an abstract interplay of light, color and sound that seem to materialize invisible energies that animate our planet. The surfaces reflect rays of light in shifting patterns depending on the movement of viewers within the space.


