Sunday! Last Day to Catch the Spectacular 2024 LA Art Show! We Hope to See You There...

Yesterday was a thrilling Day 3 at the LA Art Show, with a non-stop bustle of art fans exploring a wide array of exhibitions, and an extraordinary schedule of special programs – performances and panel discussions – from opening through closing time.

Visitors attended an enlightening discussion about the influence of AI on memory and how it shapes our understanding of what it means to be human, with artists and curators from international museums participating in DIVERSEartLA 2024, moderated by Marisa Caichiolo, DIVERSEartLA curator.

We also enjoyed an imaginative performance by artists Amy Kaps and Kaye Freeman, assuming the roles of two sirens frolicking and fighting for their lives while sea levels rise, using only recycled and repurposed materials to create their costumes, props and set.

Later in the afternoon, a huge crowd gathered while artist / percussionist Choi Sori gave a dramatic and sensational drum performance, presented by Art in Dongsan.

We were also fascinated to see a surprise performance by New York City-based South Korean artist Dain Yoon, who used live painting as a device to illustrate a personal experience she had two years ago at the passport office.

This profound artwork, in honor of Black History Month, draws its theme from one of the last books written by Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.

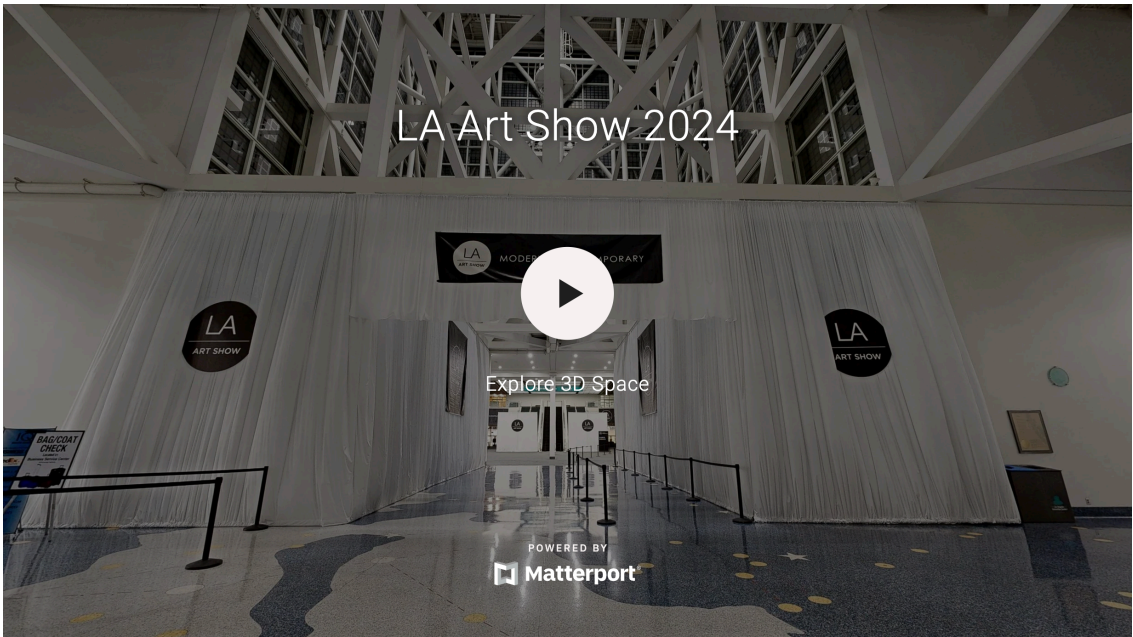
