Gallery Highlight: Returning Gallery Beatriz Esguerra Fine Art

We're delighted that Beatriz Esguerra Fine Art will return as one of our featured exhibitors in 2023. The Bogota based gallery presents the work of Colombian artists, including Pablo Arrazola, whose work will be shown at the upcoming edition of the LA Art Show.

Born in 1991, Arrazola's studio practice focuses on figurative drawing on paper, which he manipulates by tearing, cutting, scratching, scraping and rubbing. The resulting lines, textures and reliefs transform the paper into part of the composition, rather than a blank two-dimensional surface. Superimposed on the paper, his generic portrayals of children seem to have their own agency, like fully realized characters. When gallery director Beatriz Esguerra visited his studio in 2020, Arrazola spoke about one of his works in progress. "In a certain way, the paper is this figure's reality. The white-on-white background is, to a degree, infinite. The frame represents the limits of the reality this figure is inhabiting, transforming and transgressing."

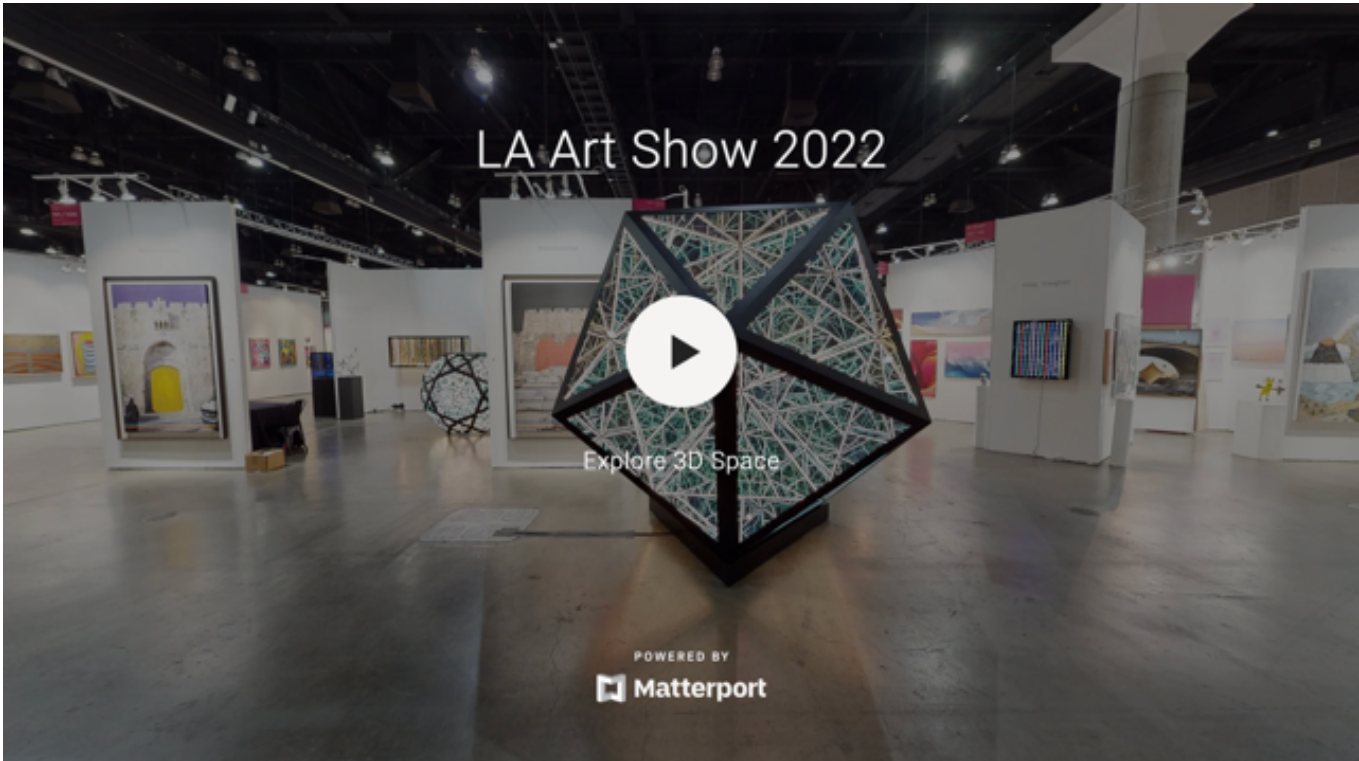

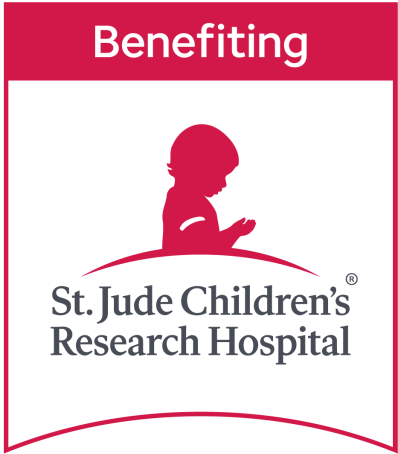

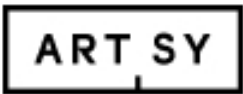
