Featured Gallery: M.S. Rau, New Orleans

We're delighted to welcome back M.S. Rau as a participating gallery in the ROOTS section of the LA Art Show this year. Our ROOTS space is a special exhibition area dedicated to honoring voices and movements from the past. M.S. Rau is among the exhibitors that showcase historical works and contemporary artists following in those traditions.

Since 1912, M.S. Rau has earned the trust of discerning collectors worldwide. In 2019, the New Orleans based gallery unveiled a multi-million dollar gallery expansion, nearly doubling in size. Today, the gallery totals nearly 40,000 square feet overflowing with important, original paintings and sculptures, along with antiques by names including Tiffany & Co., Paul Revere and Fabergé and a diverse collection of fine jewels. A real show-stopper, M.S. Rau will be presenting a spectacular selection of paintings by luminary European, Asian and American artists at this year's fair.

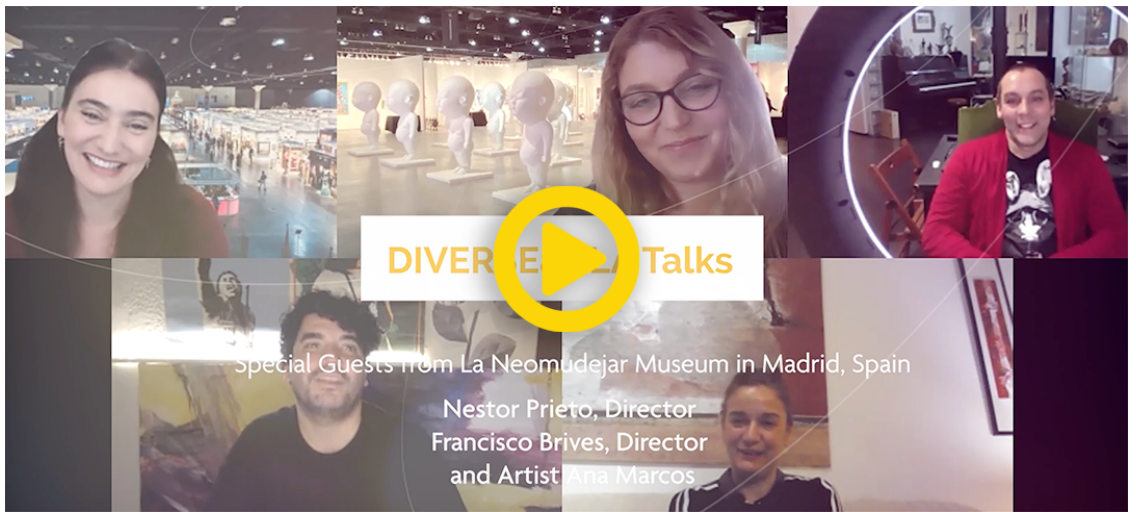

13-year old Budding Artist Paints St. Jude Tree of Life

We're very pleased that [St. Jude Children's Research Hospital®](#) will return as our charity partner for 2021. Here's an inspiring story about a young St. Jude patient who loves to paint.

Victoria Rubio-LeBron's painting, "The St. Jude Tree of Life," tells the story of her experience as a patient at St. Jude, where she received proton therapy treatments after two surgeries on a brain tumor, called meningioma, which is rare in children. The trunk represents St. Jude Children's Research Hospital. "The long branches are all the departments, facilities and all the different parts of St. Jude. The little branches are all the doctors and nurses, and the donors, as well, who take care of St. Jude," said Victoria.

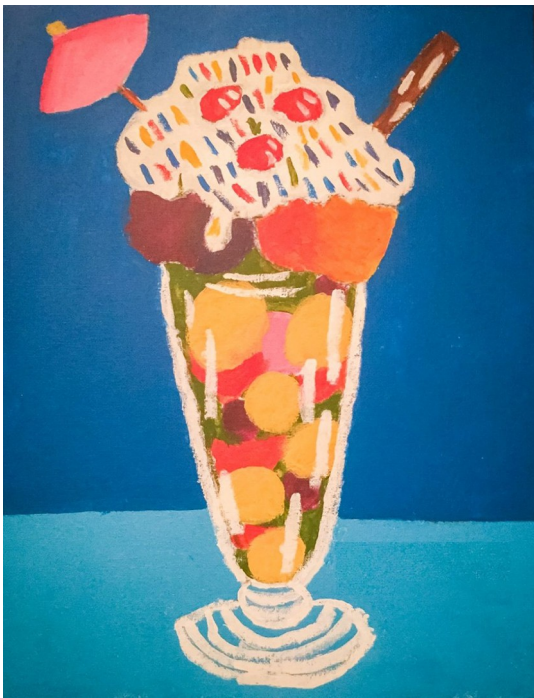
“Then all the leaves are the patients who are there. And if you look at it, there are some falling leaves. Those represent the patients who have passed away.”

The 13-year old artist uses bright colors in her uplifting paintings, like her artistic contribution to the World Golf Championships-FedEx St. Jude Invitational. Her painting of an ice cream sundae was featured along with the art of other patients on TaylorMade putter covers used by golfers Dustin Johnson, Rory McIlroy, Jon Rahm, Jason Day, Matthew Wolff and Collin Morikawa.

Victoria’s paintings have been auctioned to raise money for St. Jude, and she’s collaborated with a noted South Florida artist, Alex Mijares, on the T-shirt art for the annual Team Victoria Walk/Run fundraiser. While she has said she’d like to be a radiation oncologist when she grows up, Victoria always wants art to be a part of her life.



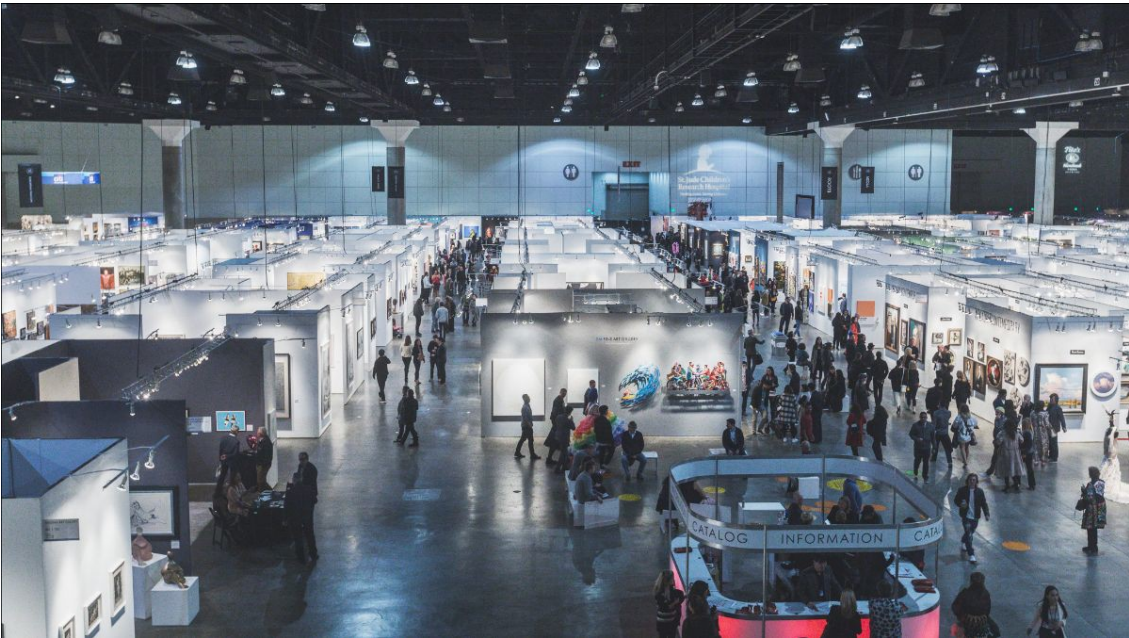
The St. Jude Tree of Life by Victoria



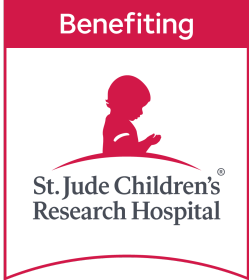
Ice Cream Sundae by Victoria

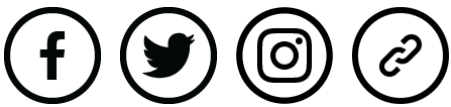
