

Among the many anticipated highlights of 2022, DIVERSEartLA returns with a new ecological lens. Curated by Marisa Caichiolo, the next edition of DIVERSEartLA will examine artistic portrayals of the environment and the role of humanity's place in the

world. The exhibition will foster an important dialogue about the Earth's past, present and future, encouraging further discussion about the global climate crisis and approaches to solving it.

For the upcoming edition of the LA Art Show, DIVERSEartLA invites art museums and institutions to partner with science and environmental museums in creating a world of immersive experiences focusing on the looming impact we face as the planet warms.



Caichiolo explains, "DIVERSEartLA 2022 will encourage visitors to confront the complex challenges of our global climate crisis and imagine potential solutions. This topic is at the heart of a growing number of art narratives, including exhibitions built with high-tech innovations, designed to inspire artistic appreciation and the desire to respond to environmental challenges, reinforcing the value of translating environmental advocacy into art."
