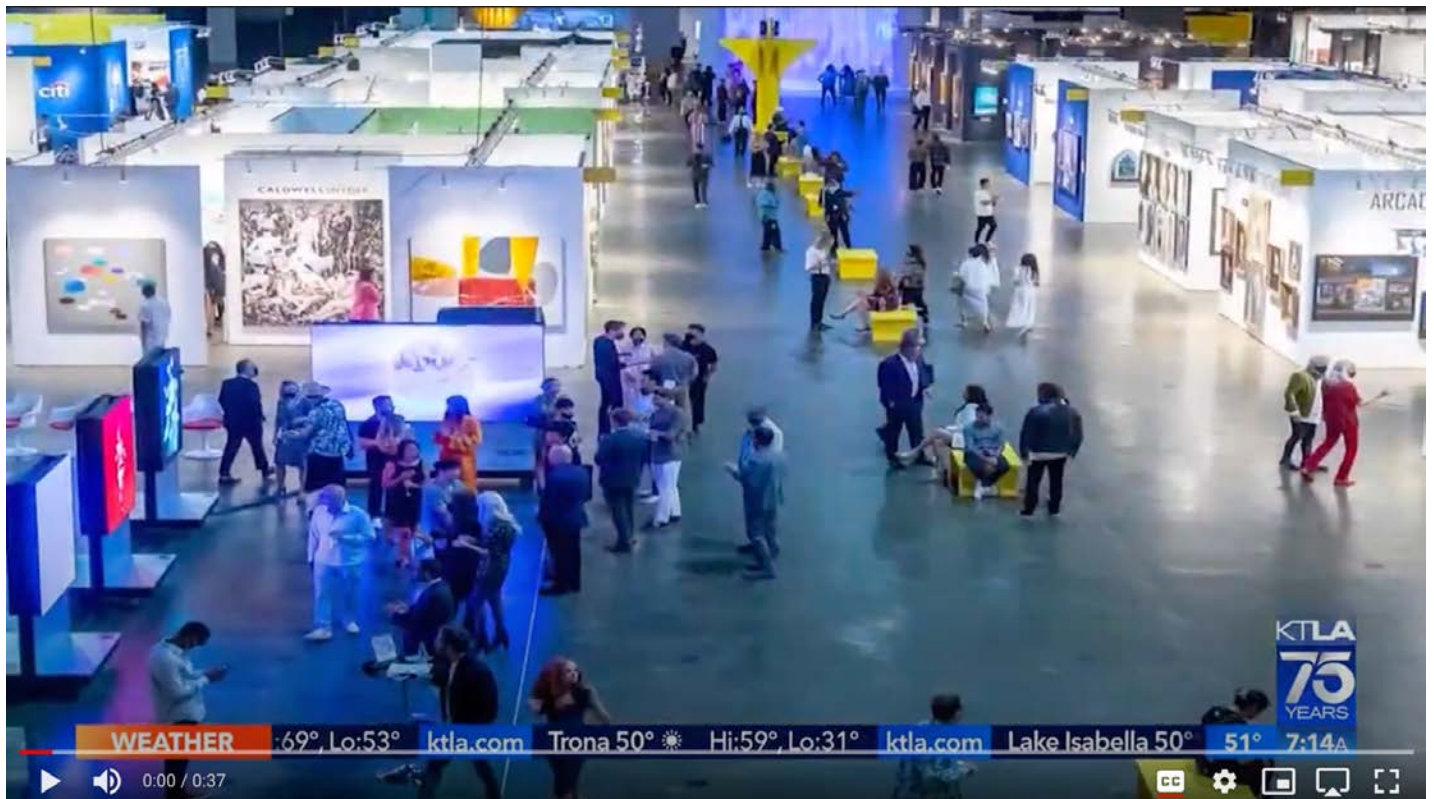

L.A. ART SHOW'S BEASTS, BYTES AND 'BERGS

The stalwart fair returns with issues engagement and safety protocols

The L.A. Art Show has been in continuous operation for decades. Their January 2020 edition was one of the last big events of the Before Times, had we but known it then. They pushed the 2021 edition to July, weathering the Delta variant with a smaller footprint and elaborate safety protocols. Two

years later, the little big show that could will return to its January roots — with a thoughtful covid-safety plan including proof of vaccination and mask-wearing, and a futures-focused curatorial vision engaging with the threat of climate change and the promise of the metaverse.

One of the unexpected highlights of

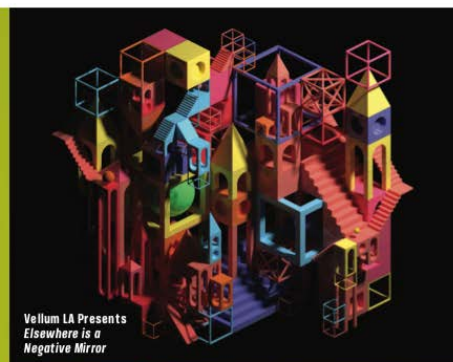
the rogue summer 2021 edition was the excitement around digital and crypto art — NFTs and otherwise — as galleries and independent projects devised mesmerizing and photogenic screen- and sculpture-based vessels for presenting disembodied work. Visitors dug these projects with their aura of newness and

the pizzazz of luminosity and movement at a larger scale evocative of contemporary painting. Clearly, there will be plenty of that again this time, as multiple exhibitors explore the commonalities and contrasts between the new media frontier and the traditional art space.

Vellum LA — who led the previous edi-

tion's charge into the brave new world — is back, this time keying off their recently inaugurated brick-and-mortar space in West Hollywood. Elsewhere is a Negative Mirror is curated by cryptoart impresari-

os Jesse Damiani and Sinziana Velicescu, and features 10 artists exploring architectural motifs — and what if any rules exist for constructing place — in the new digital universes being built. Showing works

by Saks Afridi, Kirk Finkel (untitled, xyz), Vince Fraser, Mari K, Petecia LeFawnhawk, Nate Mohler, Sabrina Ratté, Nicolas Sassoon, and Thato Tatai, Elsewhere is a Negative Mirror underscores the physical mutability of the future world by happening simultaneously as an in-person exhibition fair and also at Vellum LA across town, as well as in an online auction with SuperRare.

KP Projects' Merry Karnowsky has been a destination for the vanguard of contemporary figurative painting, embracing new currents in visual culture from street, illustration, lowbrow, visionary and outsider voices for decades. Her program is known for featuring titans of narrative symbolism like painter and digital artist Johnny Rodriguez, aka KMNDZ,

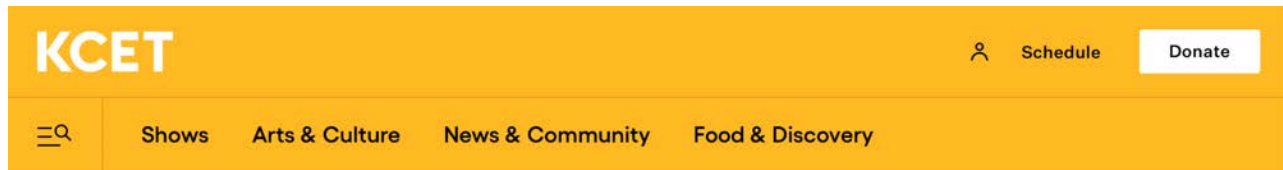
who in partnership with LGND, will be the gallery's first foray into the NFT space.

KMNDZ's Little Beasts engages the energy of hybridity in a series introducing a cohort of robots and animal characters. Manifested first as hand-drawn mixed media works, before being raptured into the NFT energy field of the blockchain, the recombinant creatures themselves speak to the quality of the transcendent that propels the metaverse forward. Honoring the artist's Latino roots in aspects of their colorful magical auras while also updating his favorite folkloric traditions in a post-Disney, post-digital mythos, it's only fitting the works themselves would bridge the gap between history and the future in art historical terms as well as materials.

In another part of the show, the pervasive themes of the environmental crisis also find a tech-forward expression in Arts Help's presentation of Conscious Crypto Creator: ICEBERGS. The Con-

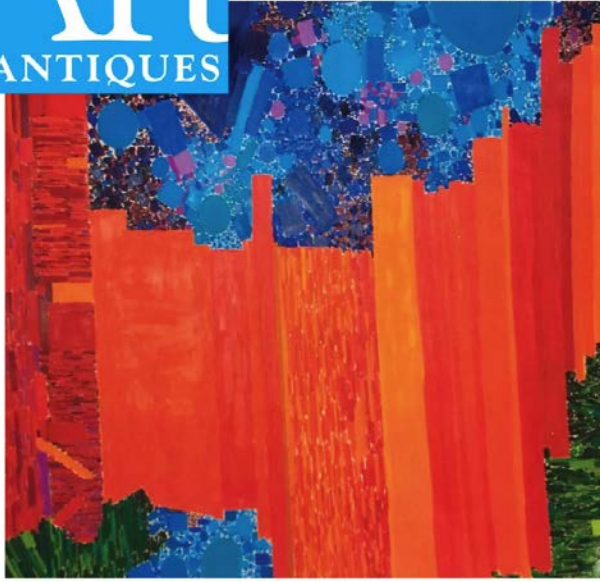

IN PERSPECTIVE

The LA Way

JUST SIX MONTHS after its last edition, the LA Art Show is returning to its usual venue, the LA Convention Center, from January 19-23. January is the traditional time frame for Los Angeles' largest and longest-running art fair; the June schedule was a special one to make up for the cancellation due to the pandemic last winter. Producer and director Cassandra Voyagin is back after her debut at the show last time, curating an impressive array of modern and contemporary art dealers from the U.S., Europe, and Asia. DIVERSEartLA 2022, a sector of the fair, is being curated by Maria Caicholo and features installations that "will encourage visitors

to confront the complex challenges of our global climate crisis and imagine potential solutions." As it has been since 2015, the St. Jude Children's Research Hospital is the beneficiary of the LA Art Show, receiving 15 percent of ticket proceeds.

A very diverse roster of international dealers will be presenting top-quality works of art. Rebecca Hosack Art Gallery of London will offer works by British artist Laurence Jones, whose hyperreal paintings use perspectival shifts and a screen-like finish to meld fiction with reality. His *Night Pool (Pink)* is particularly appropriate to the fair, as it depicts a iconic view of Los Angeles with lights shining in darkness.

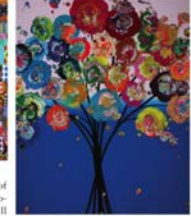


Dutch artist Carla Kr a n e n d o n k makes large-format mixed-media works inspired by her travels in



West Africa.

At the booth of Arcadia Contemporary, fairgoers will find works by artists including Lo Chan Peng of South Korea, whose oil on panel *The Gazer in The Vanity* (2021) is a disturbing portrait of vulnerability, and Annaz Stanley of Nigeria, whose graphite on paper *People and Paper III* gives a new twist to the human figure. Simard Bolodeau Contemporary of Los Angeles will have Yalda Sepahpour's *Tigers* (2021), an oil on canvas showing a mythical-looking woman flanked by two tigers, as well



as Alfredo Romero's *Urban Messages* (2019), a palimpsest-like strappo (a process of attaching canvas to a fresco and then pulling it off) and silver leaf on canvas abstraction. Miruma Art Gallery of Tokyo will be offering floral abstractions in pigment ink and acrylic on canvas by Okuda Yuta. Pan American Art Projects of Miami will have Jorge Rios' *This was the first reflection* (2020) on view. The oil on canvas, which depicts pine trees on a snowy island bursting into flame, seem to warn of the ravages of climate change.

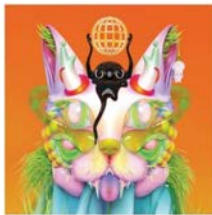

"We have **IG gallery**, which is located in Santa Monica, and this year, they're going to include neon technology and a science crossover. From **IG**, I like **Barbara Kuhn's** new Transition works, and for prints, I like **G.K. Austin's** work and how it's displayed."

"Last summer, we introduced **Volcan L.A.**, which is the first L.A. physical gallery for NFTs. The goal is to straddle digital and crypto art within the context of art history, and also educate the public on the potential of NFTs and their impact on the future of art."

"**Sinbad Bilekian Contemporary** has shown **Yada Sepulchre's** work for many years at the LA Art Show, and she is loved and sells very well. **Thai Mainland** has strong fashion and Spanish roots, and I'm Italian."

"Another introduction we made last summer was **coming back to Tex Hammond**. He's 14 years old and represented by **Aesma Arts**, a local gallery. It was his first art fair ever and he did incredibly well. He uses various media like graffiti, video games, music and abstract art."

STATE OF THE ART

The 27th annual LA Art Show spotlights diversity and environmental awareness.

After dishing out a summer show in 2021, the LA Art Show (daredevil.com) returns to the Los Angeles Convention Center in its traditional month Jan. 29 through 31 to kick off the city's 2022 art season.

"The show represents L.A.," says producer and director **Kassandra Votazis**, who's been involved in Los Angeles' longest-running art fair—founded in 1994—since 2014. "Over the past three or four years, L.A. has developed into a major capital of art. For us, I think it's important that we're always here and we're part of the moment."

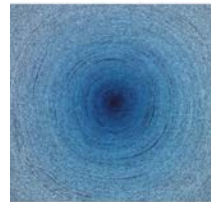
One of the country's largest international contemporary art fairs, this year's LA Art Show

will welcome more than 100 galleries, museums and nonprofit arts organizations from around the world. Los Angeles' location on the Pacific Rim makes it particularly accessible to Asian markets. "I'm very happy the crowd brings an affinity to the art," says Votazis. "Asian and European galleries can return," says Votazis. For her, the diversity of artists and genres is what distinguishes the show. "We have **DIVERSEART**, which is our gateway to the community; we have **lowhouse art**; we have traditional art. So it's really one of those fairs that allows for somebody to see a little bit of everything."

Displayed in 200,000 square feet of space at

the convention center will be 20,000 works of painting, sculpture, installation, photography, design, digital art, video and performance. Art is grouped into sections to highlight contemporary art, immersive experiences, historical works, site exhibitions, works on paper and **DIVERSEART**, the museum area Marina Calafate corner around an annual theme. "This year, we're curating it with a lens to the ecological mission and climate change," says Votazis. "We're inviting museums and institutions to partner with science and environmental museums, and together we're going to do an entire world of immersive experiences

This year's show will commence Wednesday, Jan. 29, with an opening night gala benefiting St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, hosted by a celebrity guest—who, at July's event, was Rita Ora. The fair will be open Thursday through Saturday from noon to two and Sunday from noon to two, with VIP morning hours from noon to noon Saturday and Sunday. For weekend, a show preview will have a special VIP party.

To accommodate COVID-19 safety requirements, the summer show scaled back to 20,000 attendees—which is half the usual attendance. However, due to a partnership with **Artsy** making art available online, the show doubled its sales. "All of the galleries did extremely well," says Votazis. "I think that speaks to the excitement of people to be able to get out and to purchase art and to experience art with other people."

On Wednesday night, the [Los Angeles Art Show \(LAAS\)](#) returned to its normal grounds at the Convention Center after a hiatus due to COVID. For those unfamiliar, LAAS certainly doesn't carry the heavyweight artists and galleries that you'd expect from a [Frieze](#) or [Art Basel](#), but still features a large assortment of emerging galleries from around the world. Going on 26 years and counting, LAAS is the city's longest-running international art fair, usually garnering a crowd of around 65,000 attendees per year.

The opening night gala saw far fewer, but a crowd nonetheless excited to usher in a sense of normalcy. That familiarity is short-lived as you walk past the newly branded [Crypto.com Arena](#) into a strict vaccination check at the entrance of the fair. For the time being, this is the new normal.

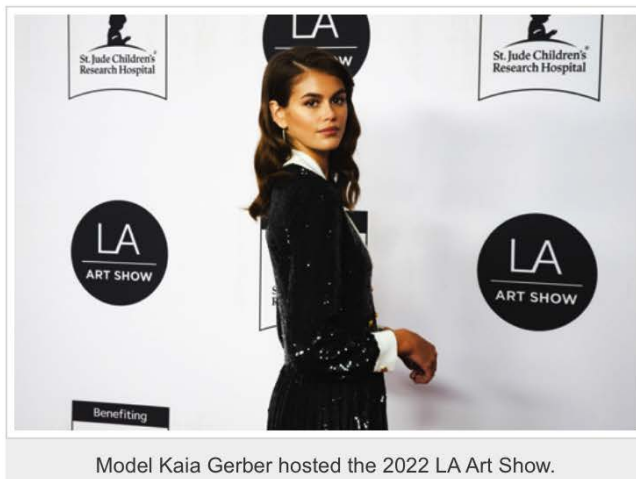

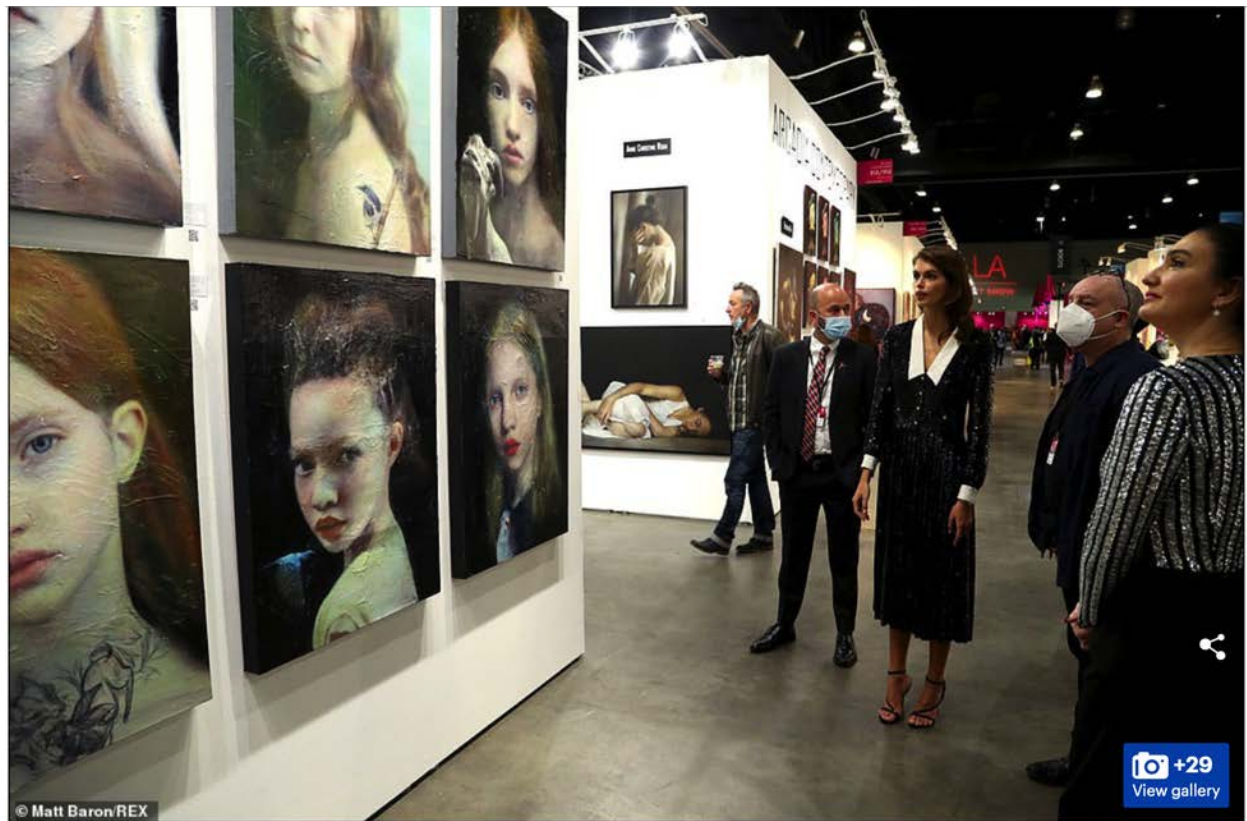

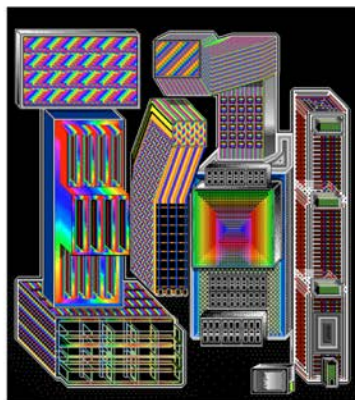

Environmental accountability is also a major theme of this year's DIVERSEartLA programming, as curator Marisa Caichio considers art's power to affect change. Across eight participating interdisciplinary projects, courtesy of venues both international (Czech Republic, Mexico (Guadalajara), Argentina, Spain, and within mere miles of the show (Skid Row, Torrance), discourses on climate change unfold at a global and hyperlocal scale, showing how climate and economic justice are inextricably linked, the effects of drought in Jalisco and unhealthy heat in Skid Row, dynamics of waste and reclamation, literal melting ice, vectors of accelerated biological evolution, and the scaffolding of society's failed cultural and even architectural propaganda of mitigation.

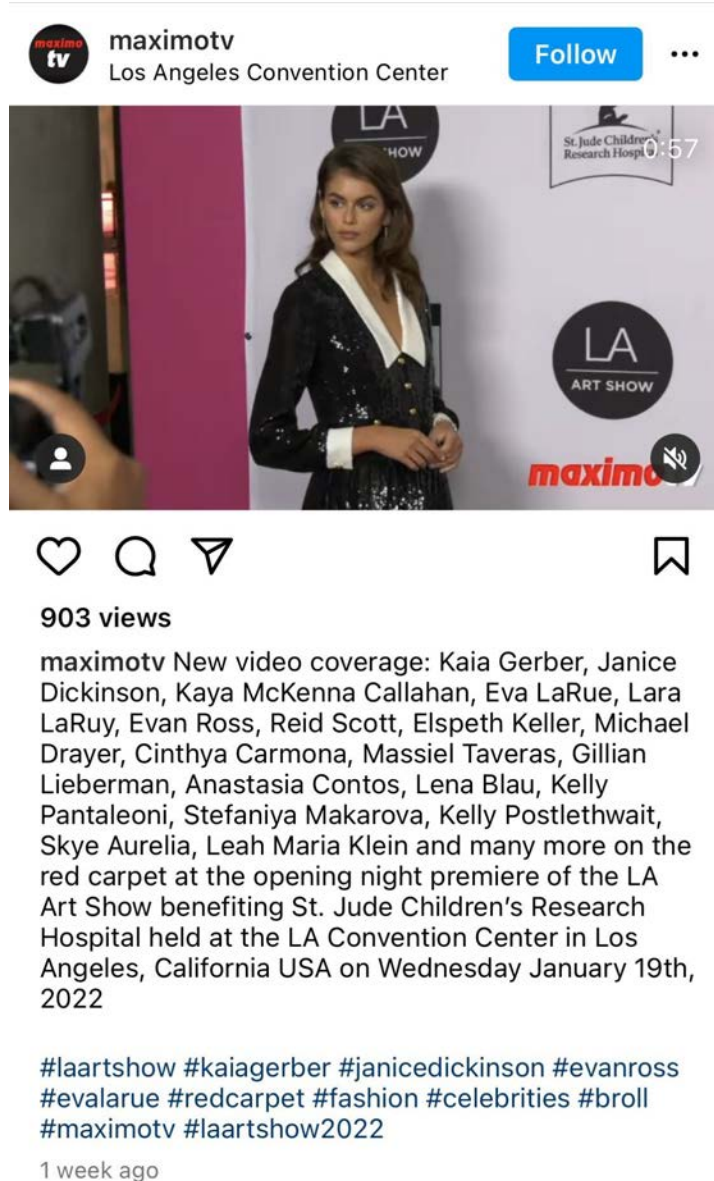

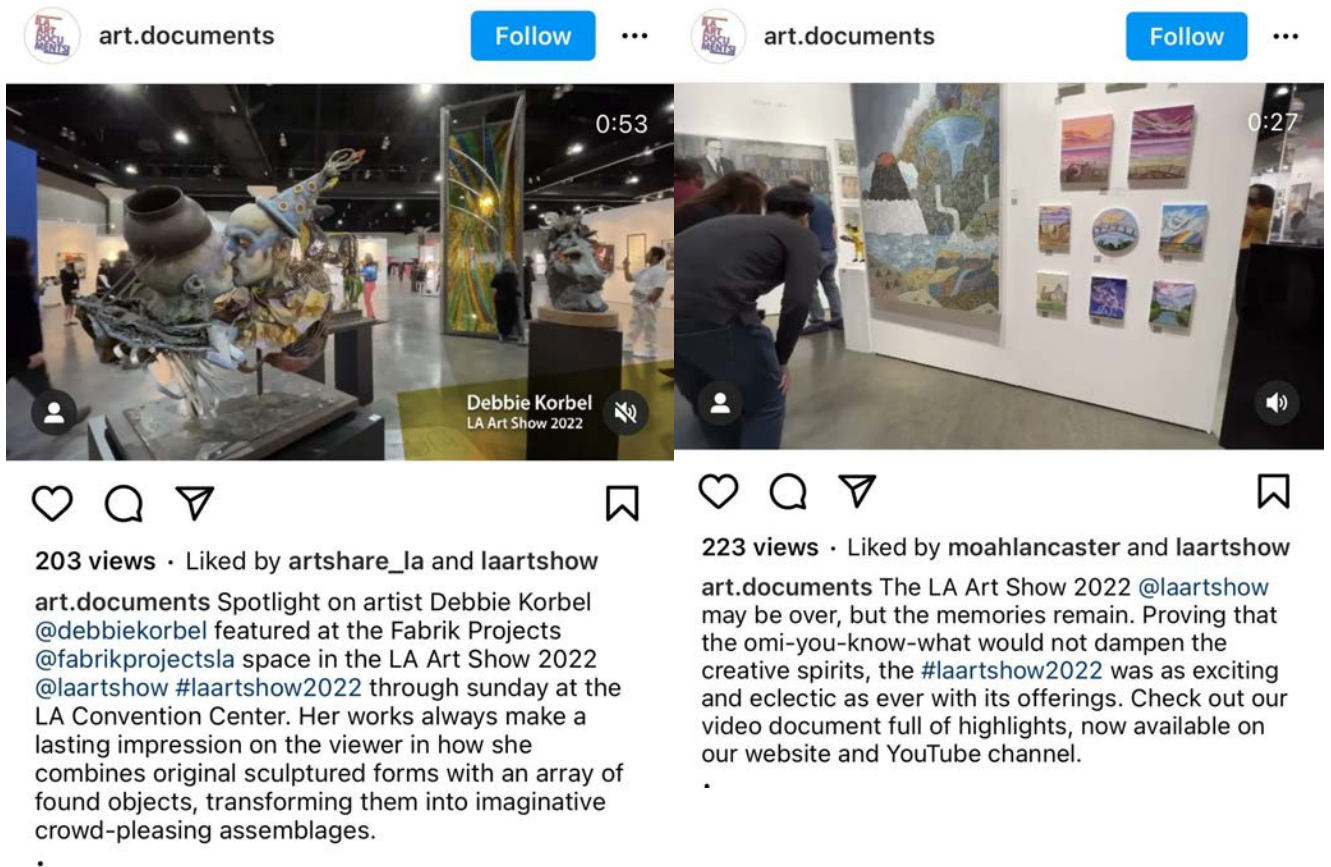
